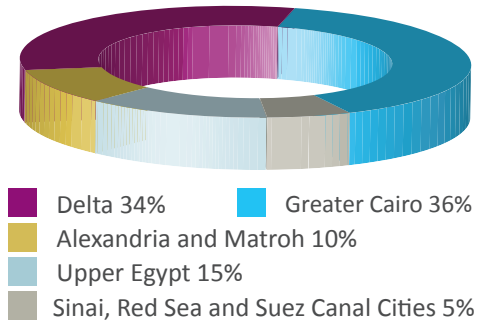

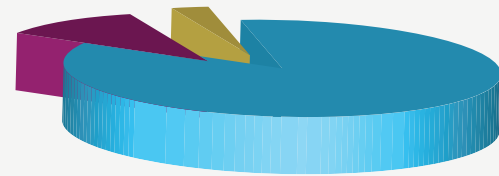

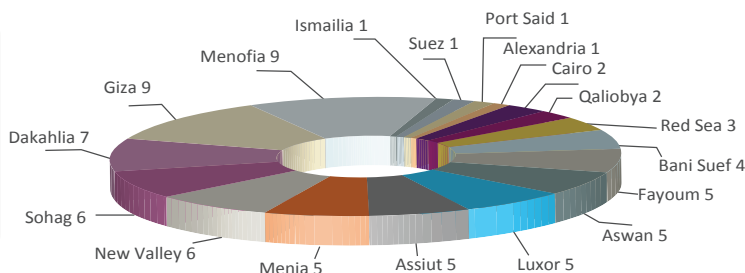


IT Clubs
